Hamelin is located in Germany (Lower Saxony) in the Weserbergland region.

With about 57,300 inhabitants Hamelin is the middle center of the district Hamelin-Pyrmont.

The Hamelin public library is located in a historic building, the Pfortmühle, directly on the Weser River.

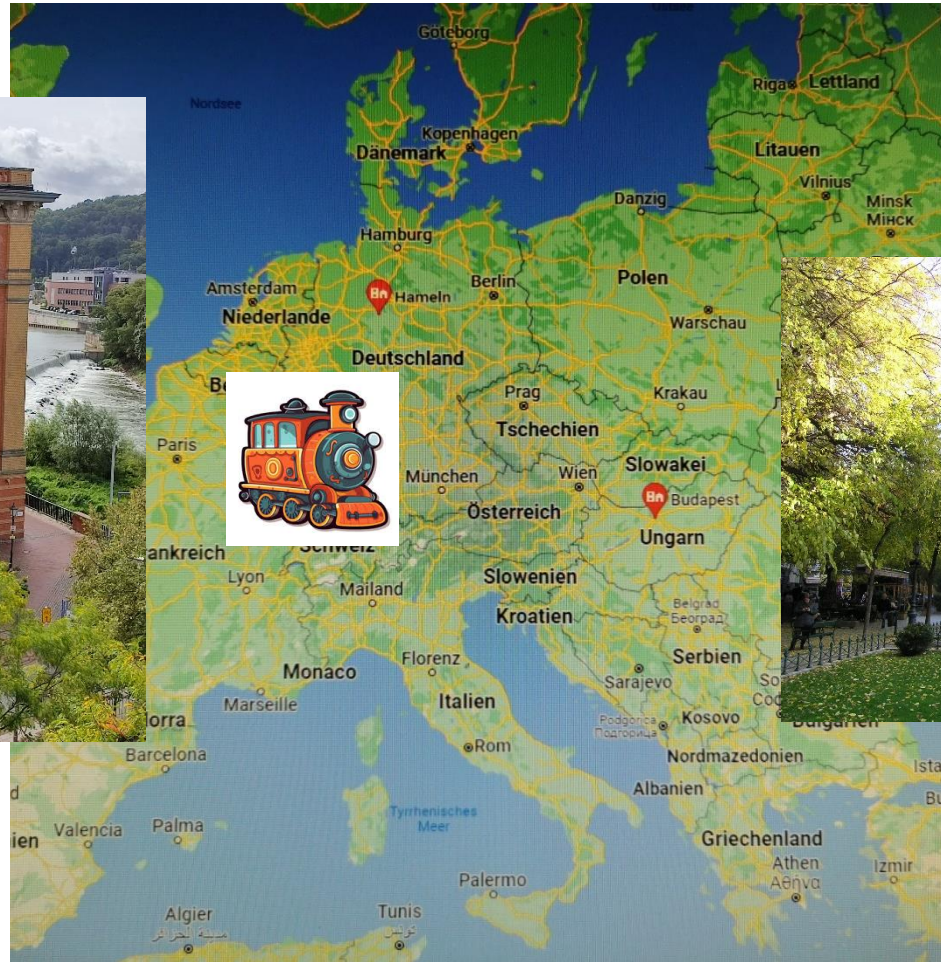
About 90.000 media are distributed on 3 floors.

There is a particular focus on four of the 17 goals of the 2030 Agenda:



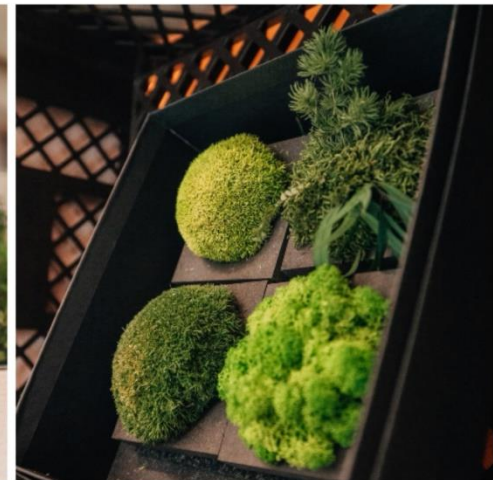
- Nr. 4: No poverty

- Nr. 13: Climate action



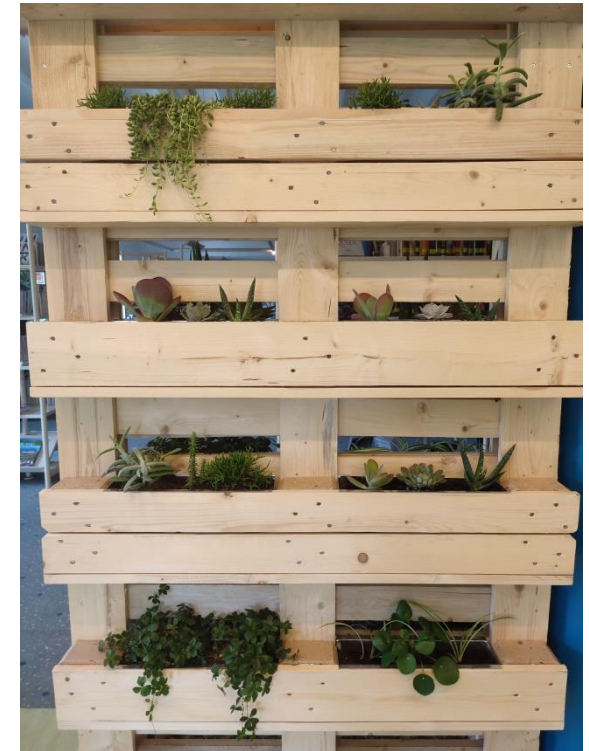
Spatial and technical equipment of the green lab for the implementation of the offers in the room

The goal of Hamelin Public Library with the Green Lab is a sustainability strategy that we can use in the future to help people implement more sustainable lifestyles



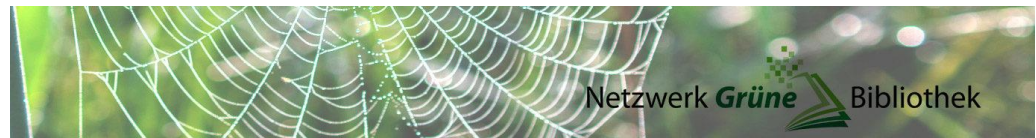
